

Important information!

We have many challenges getting our containers picked up - especially containers with:

- Metal - in which there often are spray cans (hazardous waste)
- Cardboard - unfolded boxes or some with plastic (e.g. a wine box) etc.
- Plastic - that contain hazardous bottles (look at the pictures) or polystyrene

You can deliver your hazardous waste in front of the grey metal cabinet on the left hand side of the containers. Bottles from Borup are always hazardous waste and do not put them in our regular waste containers. The same is true for bottles with ethanol that is extremely flammable.



If your waste has any of these symbols, then it is hazardous waste and you have to place it in front of the metal cabinet. Most of what we use in the kitchen and in our bathroom are categorised as hazardous waste (toilet cleaning, decalcification, spray cans (hair spray), some washing-up liquid etc.).



It is illegal

to use and you must under no circumstances use it in Jægerhaven. It is extremely toxic for the environment, highly corrosive and in danger for those who empty our containers. In addition, at the end of the day, it does not work - instead use hot water.
